FUNDING GUIDELINES – COMPETITIVE GRANT APPLICATIONS 2024 FUNDING CYCLE

PLEASE NOTE: There is a change for 2024 in how you MUST submit your Grants Application and supporting Documentation!

Every request must still have a completed multi-page Grant Application, which is submitted through the Kiwanis website, www.srvkiwanis.org. All supporting documents must be EMAILED to Grants@SRVKiwanis.org.

The following supporting documents MUST be submitted electronically in a PDF format in the same manner:

- A copy of your IRS Tax Exempt letter (unless represented by non-profit fiscal agent)
- Financial Statements, Balance Sheet, or similar financial documentation
- A copy of the Organization Budget
- A copy of the Project budget
- A list of Board Members (if applicable)
- A signed PHOTO WAIVER AND RELEASE FORM

The following guidelines are considered by the Grant Committee in making its recommendations, and, except for the Kiwanis Non-Discrimination Policy, it is not intended that each guideline must apply in all cases:

- The grant must advance a charitable or cultural purpose.
- The grantee must be of such character and reputation that the committee is reasonably certain that the purpose of the grant will be fulfilled honestly and effectively.
- Preference is to be given to grantees with which Kiwanis Club members are actively associated on a non-paid basis.
- Preference is to be given to purposes directly benefiting the San Ramon Valley community. However, we also permit a small number of the grants to be directed to purposes that can be considered regional, national, and/or international.
- Preference is to be given to grants that benefit children, the infirm or the elderly.
- Preference is to be given to grants that involve 'hands on' participation by club members, and the community at large.
- Preference is to be given to grants that will provide solace, comfort, or consolation.
- Preference is to be given to grants that have a significant influence on the desired results, such as providing seed money, resulting in matching funds, or enabling a program to exist that would not otherwise do so.

The following are excluded as potential grant recipients, in the absence of exceptional circumstances:

- Individuals
- Organizations without non-profit status (unless represented by a fiscal agent)
- Governmental entities
- Individual Schools or PTA's *b
- Sports Teams
- For-Profit Enterprises
- Organizations use of the grant proceeds for golf tournaments or similar fundraising events.
- Organizations use of the grant proceeds to award scholarships.
- Religious Institutions, except for non-sectarian projects, are open to the general public.
- Any organization which requires religious observance as a condition of receiving services
- Organizations which will not adhere to Kiwanis Non-Discrimination Policy

All applications and supporting documentation must be emailed no later than the **first Monday in March**.

All funded organizations must email a brief written summary describing the use of the granted funds not later than 12/31/24.
